Meeting Registration Forms will be date- and time-stamped upon receipt by ESA. Requests for full-week registration must be received no later than 5 PM Eastern Daylight Time on the specified deadlines or the next higher fee category will be applied. Any Meeting Registration Forms received after the Regular registration deadline (5 pm on July 15, 2010) will be processed at the Onsite Registration Desk ONLY and, for full-week registrations, Onsite fees will apply. One-Day Registration fees are the same regardless of date of registration. Advance registration for all categories will close at 5 PM Eastern Daylight Time on Thursday, July 15, 2010.
