# **Meeting Minutes:**

- 1. Welcome by Jacquelyn Gill, including introduction of John Calder, student liaison.
- 2. Minutes from 2012 meeting distributed, reviewed by attendees, and approved.
- 3. Phil Higuera attended the ESA Council Meeting and reported his observations.
  - A. Noted similarities to what was reported in the minutes from 2012
  - B. Noted that the Paleoecology Section is not widely known
  - C. ESA Membership is up; ESA is doing well, financially
  - D. All sections are asked to document their history ahead of the 2015 centennial
    - 1. JG expressed her intent to digitize binder, in accordance with above
  - E. Sections can access long-term planning grants, are encouraged to think big
    - 1. Ideas: travel grants, awards, white papers, events, strategic planning
  - F. A few motivated students are sweeping fields
    - 1. Ensure Deevey Applicants divulge other awards for which they apply
- 4. Budget, Reported by JG
  - A. Binder in transit, ESA budgetary personal unresponsive (no value reported)
  - B. However, JG is certain that the Section is in the black
  - C. In fact, ESA has requested that the section spend down its budget
    - 1. On what can we spend this money?
      - a. All agreed that student travel grants would be a good idea
      - b. Considerable discussion of how much (range = \$250 \$500)
      - c. JG will:
        - i. Figure out average award across sections
        - ii. Draft proposal, get things moving
      - d. Everyone agreed, help students in need, not those who aren't
  - D. Supplying lunch for business meeting is a waste of money
    - 1. Motion made to cease this expenditure, motion passed
  - E. Do we want to host a mixer?
    - 1. This conversation fizzled out, no motion made
- **5.** Website, Reported by JG
  - A. ESA has required movement to World Press format
  - B. But, has been unresponsive to inquires
  - C. Student paid to update website (via long-term planning grant)
  - D. But, content not yet live, due to ESA unresponsiveness
  - E. JG wants to move all out-going communication to blog format

- F. Jessica Blois: How does information get funneled to blog?
  - 1. Answer: Anyone posts to Google Group, Chair, Vice Chair approve and re-route. Provided by (Dave Nelson and Phil Higuera)
- G. JG wants to post monthly updates to blog (papers published, ect.)
